At Grange Primary School, we are passionate that the children have high quality, regular lessons in phonics to develop their reading and comprehension skills as they move through the school.

Read Write Inc.

Since we introduced Read Write Inc. four years ago, our children's reading and phonic skills have improved enormously. The scheme is fast paced, fun and encourages plenty of participation by the children. Children across the infants have 3 lessons per week in small groups where they develop their phonics, comprehension and writing skills.

Sounds and letters are practised regularly and children are taught to use their 'fred fingers' to spell and sound out words. They also learn tricky 'red' words which do not follow a spelling pattern, e.g. your, there, come.

Stories and rhymes are used to develop reading and comprehension skills.

There are specific writing tasks too which encourage children to use the vocabulary, sentence structures and ideas developed during the week.
